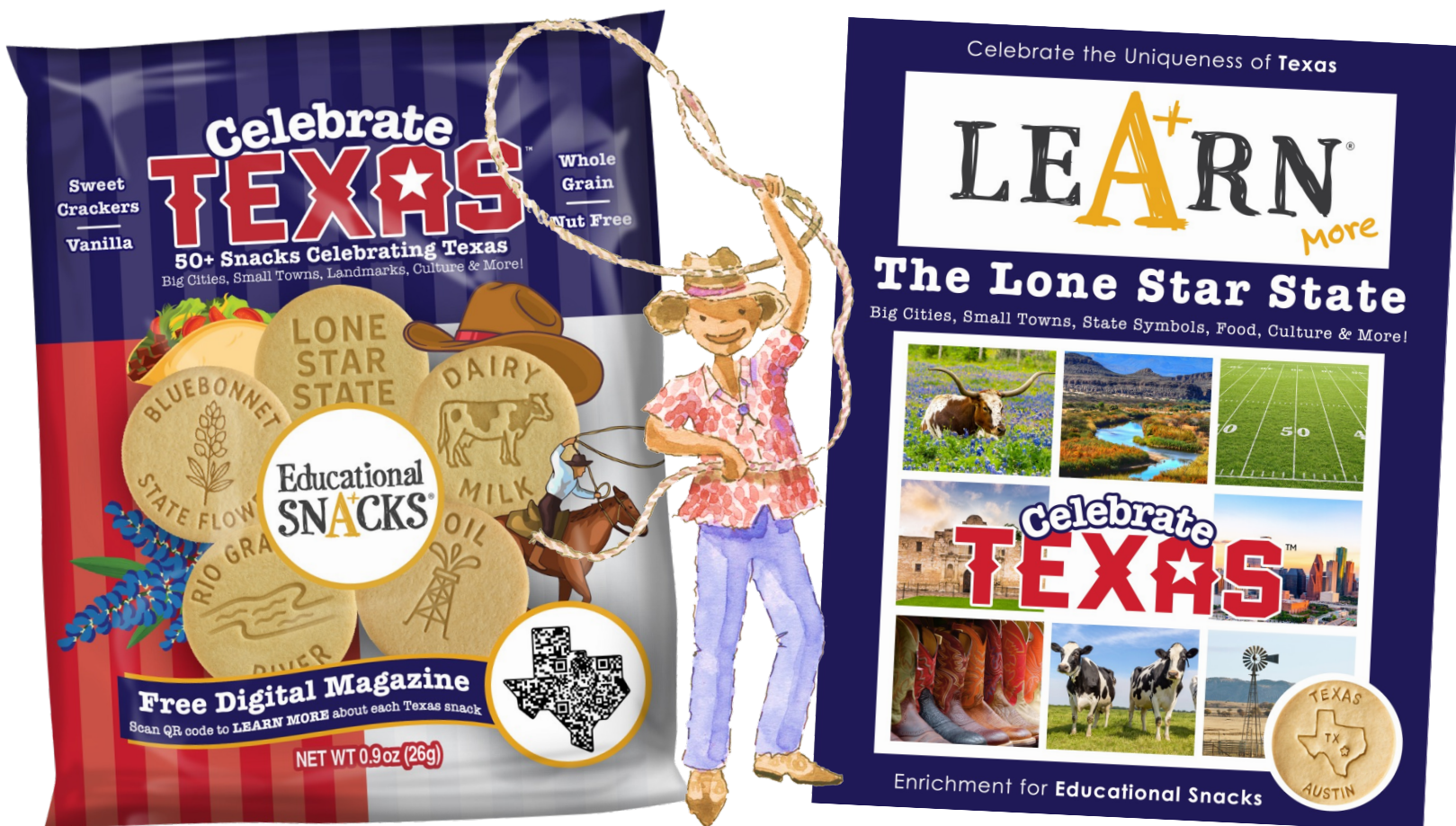

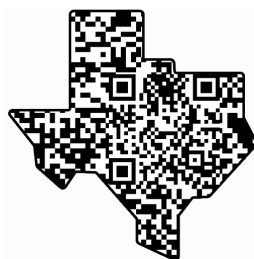

Texas Longhorn

The Texas Longhorn is the official large state mammal of Texas.

The Texas Longhorn became Texas' official large state mammal on **June 16, 1995**.

Texas Longhorns thrive in a **wide range of climates** – from hot, damp coastal region to harsh, freezing winters.

On average, an adult Texas Longhorn weighs between **1,200 & 1,500 pounds**.

Their horns can extend **over 8 feet** from tip to tip!

Most bluebonnets are blue & white. Bluebonnets grow to be 1-3 feet tall.	Corn Texas grows over 2 billion acres of corn each year. An average of 800 million bushels of corn are harvested in Texas each year. In Texas, corn is grown for 800+ years. Corn is considered a staple food AND a snack. There are over 800 varieties of corn.
